6. When Courtney makes fairy gardens, and the steps are described in the story, can you visualize the garden? Has learning about fairy gardens made you want to make one for yourself?
7. Courtney slyly invites a few suspects to her shop for tea. She also goes to a new crime scene and discovers a major clue. Do you like her abilities to suss out information? Does any of it feel unnatural to her character?
8. Brady's ex-wife has come to town for the art festival with her superstar husband. Did you enjoy the scenes where she and Brady and Courtney interact?
9. There are more fairies in Carmel-by-the-Sea than Courtney first suspected. She's enjoying meeting them, one by one. Do you have a favorite fairy?
10. Did you see the ending coming? Did you guess who the killer was and why? The why is the most important, isn't it? The motive. Did you find it satisfying?
