3. Have you ever been to a flower farm? Have you ever picked flowers or strawberries or the like at a private farm?
4. There is a big reveal about Fiona in this book. Were you surprised by her history? Her duties? Her future?
5. Did you believe Daphne Flores was guilty? Did you think she would've used her own gardening tool as the weapon? Did you appreciate how much Courtney wanted to prove her innocence yet find the real killer?
6. Has learning about fairy gardening made you want to make one for yourself?
7. What did you think about Scarlet's caustic relationship with the victim, Genevieve?
8. Did you think the same murderer killed both women? Were you torn about who the suspects were?
9. There are more fairies in Carmel-by-the-Sea than Courtney first suspected. She's enjoying meeting them, one by one. Do you have a favorite fairy?
10. Did you guess who the killer was and why they did it? What was the motive? Did you find it satisfying?
